

Good news to report is the restoration of Beresford's HQ. Although a private house and not expected to be open to the public, the condition of the building before its purchase by the present owners can only be described as being 'at risk' so this is a positive development.

We have also finalised the transaction to pay for the restoration of the Fletcher memorial, which I would like us to visit if possible during the October visit.

We have also worked on building relationships with other groups with an interest in the Peninsula War, Wellington, and so on, such as the Waterloo Association, the British Commission For Military History and those involved in Portugal friendship groups.

Thanks are also due to the Portugal Embassy, for hosting our committee meetings.


Visit to Lines of Torres Vedras.

'For various reasons, mostly of a logistical nature, it will not be possible to hold the Lines of Torres Vedras Marathon this year.

It is important, however, to emphasise that we are in contact with the National Defence Ministry who has shown both interest and availability in playing a decisive role to institutionalize this unforgettable heritage of both a historical and military nature.

As a result of this situation, the event will take place on 26th May 2019. An equestrian event will also be involved'.


If you no longer wish to receive communications from the FLTV, please let us know and we will delete your contact details from our records.

Website visitor number continue to increase. Over 9,000 individuals have visited the website in the last year, an increase of 100%. We consider this a great success and in line with the stated aim of the Group to publicise the Lines.
